The mission of the Oasis Community Services, Full Service Partnership for Transitional Age Youth (OCS/FSP-TAY) is to connect with young people needing mental health services and to enhance competencies, self-sufficiency, and self-esteem in four transition domains: community life functioning, housing, employment, and education.

Through a collaborative approach, the program aims "to do whatever it takes" in assisting young people to acknowledge and develop personal choice and social responsibility while providing a safety-net of support using family, friends, and professionals.
